Modification of the constitution



Introduction of a vice-chairmanship - Why?

The main reason for this major modification is the limited time available for the chairman of the society often leading to the difficulty to find a candidate for the next term of 2 or 2x2 years. This can easily be explained by the constant increase in the work load for everybody working in industry but also in academia. You know our daily life becomes always more stressful, leaving less time for dealing with issues of importance for ESACT. The creation of the Vice-Chairman position will provide the possibility for the Chairman to delegate parts of his tasks to the Vice-Chairman, in addition, the Vice-Chairman is the person who will replace the Chairman for all tasks when the Chairman is prevented/hold-up. In addition, in order to introduce the Chairman to his future task he might pass via the office of Vice-Chairman. For these reasons, the ESACT Executive Committee thinks that the creation of a Vice-Chairmanship is of interest for the society and the society's members.
