## **Change in New Membership Policy**



Because of substantial benefits from reduced Meeting registration fees (~300€) we observe a rush of new applications for membership between December and March before each General Meeting.

A large portion of these new members do not pay membership fees  $(20 \mbox{\ensuremath{\&cl}{e}}/\mbox{\ensuremath{e}}/\mbox{\ensuremath{e}})$  beyond the first year and generate a lot of administrative work to chase them for payment and to keep track of membership status for each General Meeting.

#### **Decision of Executive Committee on 07/06/2009:**

From now on new members will have to pay **5 years of membership fees** in advance upon acceptance of their membership application.

Continuing members are encouraged to settle their fees for several years at a time
